SHAESTA WAIZ KEYNOTE SPEAKER

Shaesta Waiz became the youngest woman to fly solo around the world in a single-engine in 2017. The global flight was launched through her non-profit, Dreams Soar, which aims to inspire the next generation of STEM and aviation professionals.

Waiz's upbringing was turbulent. Born in a refugee camp, Shaesta and her family traveled from Afghanistan to America in 1987 to escape the Afghan-Soviet war. They lived in an underprivileged school district where substitute teachers, sharing textbooks with classmates, and witnessing friends drop out of high school was the norm. It wasn't until she found aviation that she started thinking about having a career and attending college. Waiz is now a commercial pilot who has a Bachelors's and Master's degree in aviation.

SHAESTA'S STORY

Through Dreams Soar, Shaesta is brining tech-forward and innovative solutions to the aviation workforce. Waiz currently serves as a STEM Ambassador to the Federal Aviation Authority

(FAA). She is the host of the AVIATE with Shaesta podcast, where she provides women in aviation to express themselves, along with the challenges they face as a minority in the aviation and aerospace industry. Shaesta is a mother and wife of an airline pilot. She enjoys cooking, reading, and advocating for women.
